I am an experienced archive researcher and producer with over 25 years' experience. My knowledge of stills and footage along with the technical copyright, cost and implications is comprehensive. I have worked in most areas of production, including documentary, entertainment, music, news drama, current affairs sport and children's television. I have extensive contacts for both domestic and international sources of material.

Previous to working in Production I worked for 4 years for BBC Information and Archives (1997 – 2001). This gave me a solid grounding in the working of footage libraries which is invaluable when working on productions.

From December 2018 to August 2020, I was engaged as the Content Manager for the footage library Framepool. The role involved negation of representation deals with filmmakers worldwide.
